History of Int'l Relations (UOLDELUL CHELATI DIRAR)

The course deals with the development of the system of international relations from WW 1 to the end of the Cold War. Students will be introduced to the complex interplay of global politics and to its development in historical perspective. Through highly interactive lectures and group activities, students will discover the web of complex developments in international relations which shape our contemporary life, with an emphasis on the global involvement of states, societies and even diaspora communities. A special attention will be paid to the development of regionalism and to its role in fostering transnational trade exchanges as well as promoting shared notions of citizenship, governance and welfare.
